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

WHO YOU TEACH

Because every student learns differently, *Radiant Life Toddlers & Twos* studies include multiple activity options that target the four basic learning styles. That way, you can tailor your lesson to meet the needs of your students. Here's how your students learn:



SEEING

(visual)

Micah likes to "see" his world. He enjoys colors, contrast, posters, illustrations, and videos, but gets bored when there are no visuals.



HEARING

(auditory)

Jayden "hears" her world. She responds well to verbal interaction and enjoys being involved in discussion and debate, but becomes bored when she hears information she already knows.



TOUCHING

(tactual)

Jack likes to get in touch with his world. He needs to feel good about new concepts and learns best when he can manipulate objects with his hands.



MOVING

(kinesthetic)

Madison loves to experience her world. She moves a lot during class and enjoys participating in active illustrations like dramas and hands-on activities.

TEACHER FOCUS

The story of Noah and the ark has always been popular with children and adults alike. Be creative during this unit.

- Look for opportunities to help the children enjoy this story.
- Possibly create a cardboard boat for them to climb into.
- Let them pretend to be animals or pretend to find animals.
- As they become familiar with the story, let them help tell it each Sunday.

The children will not only learn about a popular Bible story, they will also be learning important concepts, such as trust and obedience. They can hear that Noah listened when God said to build an ark. They will hear how Noah obeyed God and built a big ark, and how Noah trusted God to keep him, his family, and the animals dry.




Guided Play
Toddlers love to play! In fact, research tells us that it's one of the best ways toddlers learn too. That's why *Radiant Life's Toddlers & Twos* lessons teach children through guided play. Guided play helps your children:

- Develop skills (like listening and eating properly)
- Gain knowledge (like Bible songs and stories about how God loves them)
- Organize what they already know (by reviewing the Bible story or by sorting items)
- Enjoy the learning process (by participating in activities that are age appropriate)

UNIT 4 — Bible Stories at Church

Toddlers & Twos is whole morning curriculum. Feel free to adapt the centers and activities to best meet the needs of your children. Remember to find the "teachable moments" as the children play. With this format you don't have to do everything as a group. The curriculum is set up to do with one child at a time or a few children at a time. (See pages 6 and 7 for Guided Play article.)

WELCOME

Greet each child as he or she arrives. Help the child attach a sticker to the "Attendance" poster.
Sing "This Is the Way We Give" (track 10) from the CD as the children give their offerings.

- **I am so glad you came to church today.**
- **Today we will learn how Noah trusted God.**

WORSHIP

Lead the children in singing "The Animals Went Marching" (track 9). Also sing, "Noah's Job" (track 8). (See pages 12-13 for the lyrics and music.)

- **Thank You, God, for Bible stories we hear at church. Amen.**

ACTION VERSE

Lead one or more children at a time in the Unit 4 action verse.

God brought the animals big, Big, BIG.
(Spread arms wider and wider.)

God brought the animals SMALL, Small, small.
(Bring hands closer and closer together.)

God brought the animals tall, Tall, TALL.
(Raise hands higher and higher.)

God brought the animals, ALL, all, all.
(Turn in circle while saying "all".)

Guided Play

BIBLE STORY

Use this Bible Story and the Unit 4 Bible Storybook from the Guided Play Kit each week this unit. Feel free to tell the story to one child or a few children at a time. The children can also listen to the Bible story on the CD (track 4).

Noah was a good man. Noah loved God. *(Give child toy man.)*
Noah was a daddy. Noah had three boys—Ham, Shem, and Japheth. *(Give child three toy men.)* **God had a job for Noah. God said, "Noah, build a BIG boat."** *(Give child toy saw and hammer.)*
(Show page 1 of the Storybook.) **Noah and his boys built a BIG boat. They sawed wood. Saw, saw. They hammered nails. Tap, tap. They built a big, BIG boat.** *(Place a big toy boat or boat made from a box on the table.)*
(Show page 2 of the Storybook.) **All kinds of animals climbed into Noah's big, BIG boat. Bunnies hop, hopped into the boat. Horses trot, trotted into the boat. Birdies flew into the boat. Then Noah and Mrs. Noah and all three boys climbed into the boat. God shut the door.** *(Let child put his toy men and toy animals in the ark.)*
(Show page 3 of the Storybook.) **Outside, rain began to fall. Pitter, patter went the rain.** *(Sprinkle water over the child's fingers into a dish. Dry the child's hand with a towel.)* **The boat floated on the water. Up, up, up went the boat. Noah and the animals sailed across the water.** *(Lift "ark" as if it is floating on water.)* **Then God made the wind blow. Wooo. The water went down, down, down. The boat went down, down, down.** *(Lower "ark.")*
(Show page 4 of the Storybook.) **Noah and the animals climbed out of the boat. Out hopped the bunnies. Hop, hop. Out trotted the horses. Trot, trot. Away flew the birdies.** *(Let child help remove toy men and animals.)* **Noah looked up. He saw a beautiful rainbow in the sky.** *(Give child a laminated paper rainbow.)*
God took care of Noah and the animals. God takes care of you.

SAMPLE TEACHER GUIDE LESSON

Questions, key words, and statements are printed in bold and are followed by response hints and commentary that specifically address the issues being raised. Even if your students don't respond, asking the questions will still get them thinking.

HELPFUL HINT: If you don't want to use the questions, simply turn them into statements and summarize the information that follows.

Radiant Life Toddlers & Twos lessons focus on using varied and interesting ways to reinforce the weekly Bible verse for all your students' learning styles. This method—more effective than simple repetition—helps insure your class is internalizing a new Bible verse every week.

Your active students will have their hands full (keeping your own a little less) and get more from your lessons with scribbling on the lesson-related **Coloring Book** Page.

Guided Play BIBLE VERSE

Hear the word of the Lord. Jeremiah 31:10 (KJV)
Hear the word of the Lord. Jeremiah 31:10 (NIV)

Sing "Special Book" (track 11) from the CD. Open a Bible to Jeremiah 31. Repeat the verse several times with actions.

Hear (*cup ear*), **the word** (*put hands like an open book*), **of the Lord** (*point up*).

Guided Play COLORING PAGE

Every week, pass out the *T2 Coloring Book* page for the week's lesson to each child. Let the children color both sides. Talk with the children about the Bible story picture and the life application picture.

- **What did God ask Noah to build?** (*Ark*)
- **What did Noah put on the ark?** (*His family and animals*)
- **How did Noah trust God?** (*By building the ark*)
- **How can you trust God?** (*Answers will vary*)

Guided Play SNACK

Say a prayer before eating the snack.

Nov. 7: Give each child a cup of milk and crackers with peanut butter.

- **Noah trusted God by obeying Him.**
- **What did Noah build?**

Nov. 14: Give each child a cup of water and animal crackers.

- **Who helped Noah?**
- **Can God help us?**

Nov. 21: Give each child a small cup of Jello.

- **Who kept Noah and the animals safe on the ark?**
- **God keeps us safe too.**

Nov. 28: Give each child a cup of water and Trix cereal.

- **What colors are in the rainbow?**
- **The rainbow is God's promise that He would never flood the earth again.**



Toddlers & Twos

Choose as many **Activity Centers, Crafts,** and **Coloring Pages** as your schedule allows. Develop character skills in your young children by helping them connect the Bible story to their lives.

Guided Play CRAFTS

Nov. 7: Noah Built an Ark - Cut sponges into simple ark shapes. Give each child a piece of construction paper and a sponge ark. Show each child how to dip his ark into the paint and press it onto his paper. Let the child make ark shapes all over his paper.

- **What did Noah build?**
- **God is happy when we trust and obey Him.**

Nov. 14: Noah and the Animals - Cut a large ark shape from poster board. Allow each child to color several animal pictures from Copy Master 4 (page 44). Place a dot of glue or a rolled piece of tape on the back of each picture. Help the child press the pictures on the ark. Hang the ark on the wall for the remainder of the unit.

- **What kinds of animals did Noah take on the ark?**

Nov. 21: Noah's Zoo - Give each child a piece of construction paper and several magazine pictures of animals. Let him choose as many animals as he wants to glue or tape onto a piece of construction paper to make a collage of the different kinds of animals on the ark.

- **How did God keep Noah and the animals safe on the ark?**
- **How does God keep you safe?**

Nov. 28: God Sent a Rainbow - Make construction paper arches out of varying colors and sizes. Give one of each color to each child. Put dots of glue on the arches and help the child press them on a sheet of white paper. With a felt-tip pen, write on the child's craft, *God sent Noah a rainbow.*

- **What did God promise Noah?**
- **What are some colors in the rainbow?**

CLOSE

Play "Let's Clean Up" (track 12) from the CD as the children help you pick up toys.

- **We can trust God to help us.**
- **We can trust God to keep us safe.**



Reflection

1. Can the children tell you who Noah was and what he built?
2. Do the children know they can trust God?



Fun, lesson-related **Activity Center Cards** provide a variety of learning opportunities and practice for your toddlers and twos.






STUDENT RESOURCES
